

DRAWING A KEY-LINE ROUND A PICTURE

Go to SELECT > ALL

Go to EDIT > STROKE

Choose (i) Width - e.g. 3 px
And (ii) INSIDE

Tick O.K.

- NOTE
1. Do NOT choose “outside” as this will produce rounded corners.
 2. The line will appear in the “foreground” colour – this is normally black unless you choose to alter it.
 3. Remember that the pixel width will vary with the resolution so that , e.g.
At 300 px/inch, 3px will be $3/300^{\text{th}}$ of an inch and
At 100 px/inch, 3px will be $3/100^{\text{th}}$ of an inch.

If you wish to add a second line a little out from the picture, just increase the canvas size as required and repeat the process when the new line will appear around the new canvas.



These lines are 3px at 300 px/inch

If you wish to add a coloured BORDER to the picture, you just choose the colour for the BACKGROUND in the bottom left of the toolbar then enlarge the canvas to the required size.

There is an unlimited array of borders and keylines you can invent like this.
